



Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Overview

Organization of Services

- **Ambulatory Behavioral Health Services** – general outpatient care at main clinic and at CBOCs, crisis care, suicide prevention
- **Community Outreach Division** – housing, justice outreach, vocational services
- **Integrated Behavioral Health Division** – home-based primary care, neuropsychology, pain psychology, primary care mental health integration
- **Intensive Treatment Division** – integrated dual disorder treatment, mental health intensive case management, psychosocial rehabilitation and recovery
- **Recovery Services Division** – detoxification, gambling treatment, motivational enhancement therapy, opiate treatment, outpatient rehabilitation and aftercare, tobacco cessation
- **Trauma Recovery Division** – military sexual trauma, post-traumatic stress disorder program

Behavioral Health Interdisciplinary Program (BHIP) - BHIP teams provide the core of outpatient psychotherapy, medication, and case management treatment. Specialty care teams are in place to meet other needs.
